Since 2008 New Jersey immunization regulations require one dose of influenza vaccine for all children 6 months to 59 months of age and attending childcare or preschool facilities. Every child six months through 59 months of age attending any licensed child-care center or preschool **“shall annually receive at least one dose of influenza vaccine between September 1 and December 31 of each year”**.

Flu vaccines are available at your child’s pediatrician’s office. Flu vaccine is also available at the Minute Clinic located in some CVS stores as well. (\*Call ahead as not all locations provide flu shots for children.) If you have any questions, please call me at 973-377-4945.

Please submit documentation for our records, which are reviewed by the Madison Health Department annually. **Documentation of at least one dose of vaccine for the current season must be presented for the child to remain at Kirby beyond January 1, 2019. Please note there is no grace period for this season for children 6 mos. – 59 mos.**
