

## Summer Day Camp Electronic Device/Smart Watch Policy

Students are not to use or bring electronic devices to summer day camp. Examples include video games, iPods or other MP3 players, iPads, or other tablets.

Cellular Phones, including watch-style phones, are to be turned off during summer day camp hours.

Cell phones may not be used to take pictures, send or receive calls or text messages, or as recording

devices. If a camper needs to call a parent, the camper is expected to use the summer day camp telephone. In an emergency situation, a parent is expected to contact a camper via the summer day camp telephone.

Watch-style cell phones, including but not limited to: Apple Watch, Cosmo, Verizon, Gizmo, Gabb, and Timex Family Connect are not permitted to be on at summer day camp.

Students will be asked to turn them off, remove them and put them in their backpack.

Electronic devices, including cell phones in use during the summer day camp hours, will be put in a safe place, and parents will be asked to pick them up from the Summer Day Camp Site Leader.

Expectations and Steps Taken:

- Campers will be asked to power the device off when arriving to summer day camp
- If the camper does not power the device off when asked and is caught with the device on, we will ask the camper to put the device in their backpack
- If the camper takes the device out and has it on again, the Site Leader will put the device in a locked cabinet. When the child is picked up from summer day camp, the Site Leader will give the device to the parent
- If the student continues to disregard the expectations of the use of electronical devices, cell phone and smart watch use, when the student arrives at summer day camp, the device will be put in a locked cabinet

Please have a discussion with your camper regarding this policy so they are aware of the expectations regarding electronic devices, smart watches and cell phones during the summer day camp hours. The Summer Day Camp team at your child's camp location will remind them upon arrival each day.
